
IN RE: Resignation of Volunteer Firefighter, John M. Duritsch


WHEREAS, Firefighter John M. Duritsch has submitted his letter of resignation from the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department; and,


WHEREAS, Mr. Duritsch has been a member of the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department since April 21, 2008, and,
