IN RE: Retirement of Part-time Police Officer – Jeffrey J. Joseph



WHEREAS, Jeffrey J. Joseph has served as a Part-time Police Officer for the Sugarcreek Township Police Department since October 17, 1983; and




FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board of Trustees wishes Mr. Joseph the very best in retirement for many years to come.


