IN RE: Retirement of Part-time Police Officer – Steven M. Scheiderer



WHEREAS, Steven M. Scheiderer has served as a Part-time Police Officer for the Sugarcreek Township Police Department since July 19, 1982; and




FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board of Trustees wishes Mr. Scheiderer the very best in retirement for many years to come.
