
IN RE: Resignation of Part-time Safer Firefighter/Paramedic Josiah K. Swaney


WHEREAS, Mr. Swaney has been a member of the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department since February 6, 2012, and,

WHEREAS, Chief Randall J. Pavlak recommends we accept the resignation of Firefighter/Paramedic Swaney,


