
IN RE: Resignation of Part-time Safer Firefighter/EMT William G. Goodpaster


WHEREAS, Safer Firefighter/EMT William G. Goodpaster has submitted his letter of resignation from the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department; and,


WHEREAS, Mr. Goodpaster has been a member of the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department since May 7, 2012, and,
