PERSONNEL:

We are in the process of hiring volunteer Firefighter/EMT's and Part time Firefighter/EMT's. Physical Agility Testing is now being held as needed.

Accomplishments/Information:

- Chief Pavlak attended Department Head Meeting
- Chief Pavlak attended Greene County EMA Board Meeting
- E71 (old 72) has extensive repair work needed done to the front end suspension and leaf springs. Annual testing and pump certification will also be completed. Estimates is around \$6000.00
- Hydrant maintenance program with Greene County Sanitary is starting May 14th. Excellent work by Firefighter Kirnec along with strong cooperation and support of Greene County Sanitary Engineering in this joint effort.
- Chief Pavlak attended Centerville's TRC meeting on projects
- Miller Circus was held on Monday, May 11th. Marshal Collier was on site before and during the event. Marshal Collier reports that everything went well and the cooperation between agencies was smooth.
- Chief Pavlak attended Chamber of Commerce Meeting
- Our heartfelt thanks to Keller Realty for providing lunch for emergency responders
- I had a couple inquires on fire insurance ratings going up in Sugarcreek Township from agents. They wanted to know if I could help them with lowering their clients cost. I have been able to help two of them in the past couple of weeks. Our citizens are very appreciative of our efforts. I am looking into this matter.
- Community input for Fire Department is scheduled for May 19th, 7:00 PM at the Bellbrook Middle School
- Received EMS reimbursement money in the amount of \$1128.35. This closes out our 2014/2015 grant.
- Engine 72 (old 71) had extensive repair work done along with annual testing and maintenance. \$6402.44
- The air conditioner on the fire side of the PSB over the administration was repaired.
- R70 is at Interstate Ford for repair on a recall notice for the ERG valve.

- ❑ Medic 73 (the reserve medic) moved to front line had the annual maintenance and repairs done at Interstate Ford. \$1621.86.
- ❑ Group effort was made to repair the communication conduit between the PSB and the cell tower. We were able to perform this repair with in-house employees and one electrician from REDDY Electric. Great job done by all!

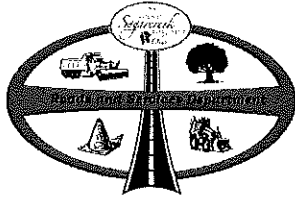
